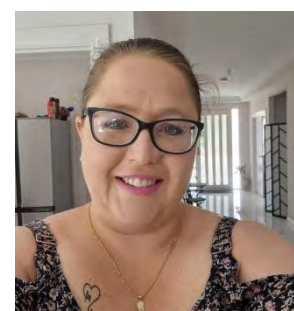

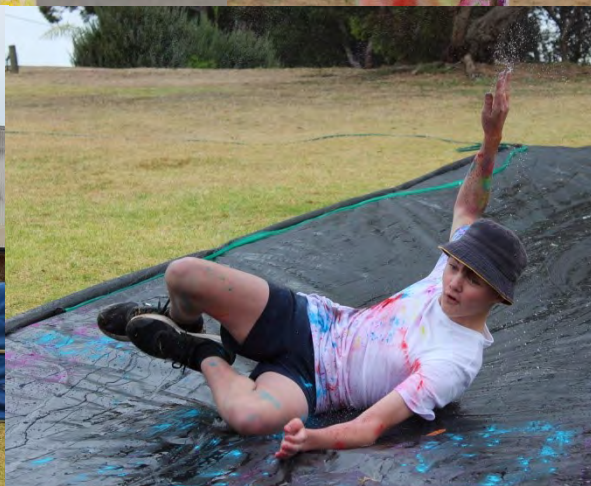

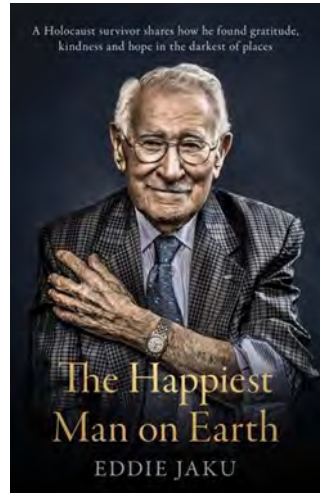


Year 12 History

Our Stage 2 Modern History students are part of a world-first project with Yad Vashem, the world's leading institution for Holocaust remembrance and education. As part of the project, students will read Holocaust survivor Eddie Jaku's autobiography, *The Happiest Man On Earth* and reflect on its universal themes of humanity, kindness and education.
