Welcome to term 3, I hope you had an enjoyable break. Recently COVID cases at the school have increased. Please continue to monitor your child for any symptoms, including a fever, cough, sore throat, shortness of breath, runny nose, loss of smell/taste, muscle/joint pains, diarrhoea, nausea/vomiting, headaches or extreme tiredness. If your child tests positive, you must inform the school immediately.

Positive COVID-19 cases must remain isolated for 7 days and must follow SA Health instructions. Siblings of confirmed positive cases are considered a close contact and should follow the advice from SA Health. This includes:

- wearing a mask when you leave the house for 7 days after your exposure date (12 years and older)
- undertake 5 rapid antigen tests over the 7 days after your exposure date (with at least 24 hours between tests and one test on day 7)
- report your rapid antigen test results if you test positive
- not attend Tier 1 sensitive settings for 14 days after your exposure date, except for the purposes of obtaining medical care or medical supplies, or except if you are an emergency services worker attending to respond to an emergency
- not attend Tier 2 sensitive settings for 7 days after exposure date, except for the purposes of obtaining medical care or medical supplies, or except if you are an emergency services worker attending to respond to an emergency
- notify your employer or school or early childcare settings that you are a close contact

We appreciate everyone's support to ensure that all necessary health advice is closely followed, and all necessary precautions are taken to minimise the risk of further transmission within our community.


