2023 Materials & Services Charges



Powered by handheld smart devices, the kit can be used to provide both virtual reality (VR) and augmented reality (AR) experiences for our students. The year 5/6 and 7/8 classes have recently used the headsets to explore foreign places, including unique landforms and landscapes, as part of their studies in Geography (HASS) with Mrs Cowan.

Staff have recently been involved in professional development to increase our use of AR/VR technologies in our classrooms and create new and unique experiences for our students.


