Congratulations to our graduating class of 2022. These students have been successful in gaining employment and university entrance. Our Senior Student of the Year, Jordan Townsend, achieved an ATAR of 93 and gained university entrance into his first preference of Clinical Exercise Physiology (honours) at Uni SA.

We have a very busy term planned both in and out of the classroom. R-6 students are part of a Cricket-blast program, fully funded by Cricket Australia and SACA and designed to increase female participation in the sport. 
