

Congratulations Amber Cameron, Teen Parliamentarian Scholarship Winner

Congratulations to Amber Cameron (Year 11) on her recent selection to take part in Teen Parliament. This program, run by The Advertiser, invites applications from Year 10, 11 and 12 students from across the state, outlining their ideas for improving the future of South Australia. Amber was one of 30 students selected to deliver a speech about her idea in Parliament and to debate the merits of the ideas of fellow participants. Amber spoke passionately about the need to introduce alternative study pathways in early secondary school. In addition to her outstanding speech, Amber was one of five participants selected to receive a \$10,000 scholarship from one of the major sponsors of Teen Parliament. Amber can use her scholarship to fund her secondary schooling and prospective tertiary studies.

Amber was also selected as a member of the State Student Representative Council (SRC), run by the Commissioner for Children and Young People. She is one of 150 representatives in Year 10, 11 and 12, including a substantial number of rural and regional representatives, selected to be part of the SRC and lead important conversations about contemporary issues facing our youth. Amber and her fellow representatives have commenced online Zoom sessions to discuss these issues and will soon meet in Adelaide to continue these discussions.
