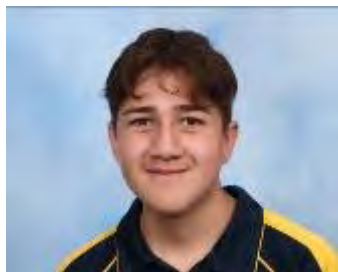

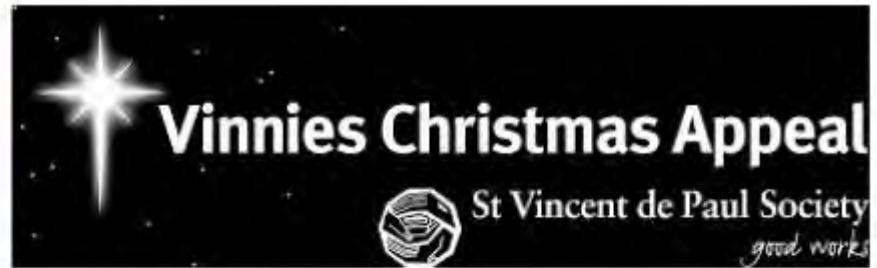

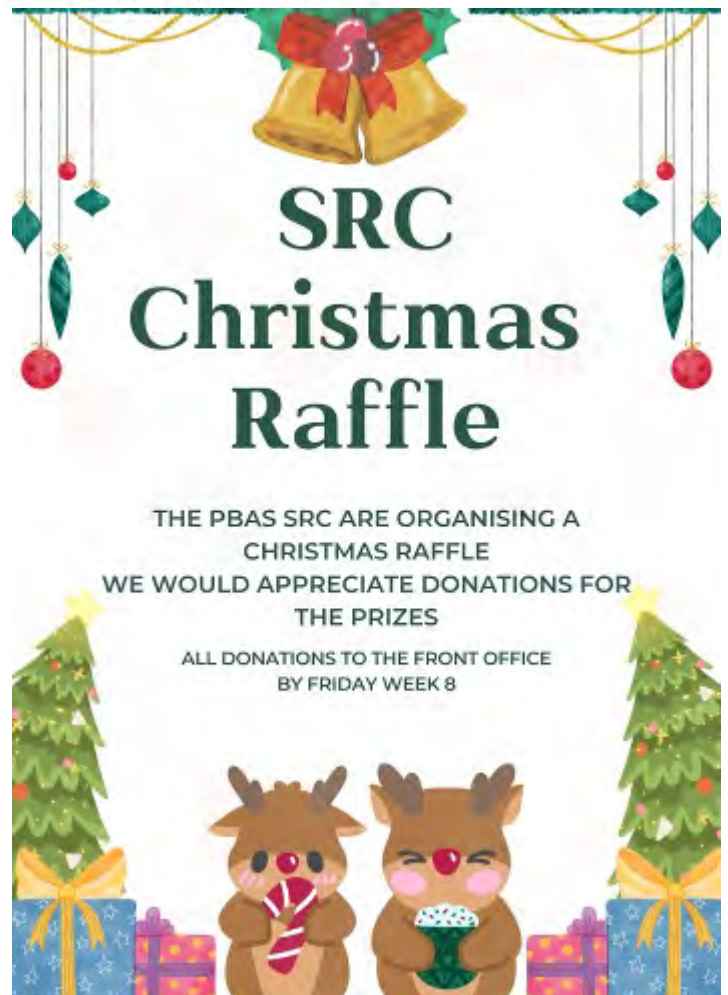
Port Broughton Area School is supporting our local, St Vincent DePaul to distribute Christmas Hampers in December.
