







My Life as a Butterfly

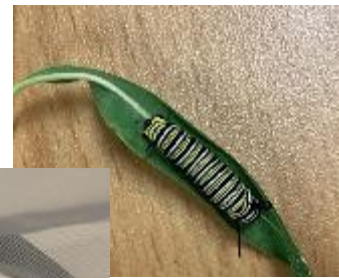
