Cross Age Tutoring in Junior Primary



This term the year 2/3 class have been using the inquiry method to create and run Cross Age activities from reception to Year 3. The students decided this term's activities would be outdoor activities and the focus would be on using imagination.

Our initial question was:-

- **How are children developing their curiosity and resilience through problem solving in a JP setting?**

After researching outdoor areas and resources, searching the internet for ideas and questioning parents, 8 activities were chosen. These activities will be run for 6 weeks with children in Mrs Stringer's and Ms Bowley's classes having the opportunity to do three activities each. Activities included potion making, gardening, clay, photo frame design, obstacle course, mud kitchen, nature painting and pine cone creation.

Ms Ingram's class will receive feedback from groups each week on how to improve the activities via video recording.

In Maths we are currently learning about graphs and we collected leaves to sort into size and colour, and record on our graphs.

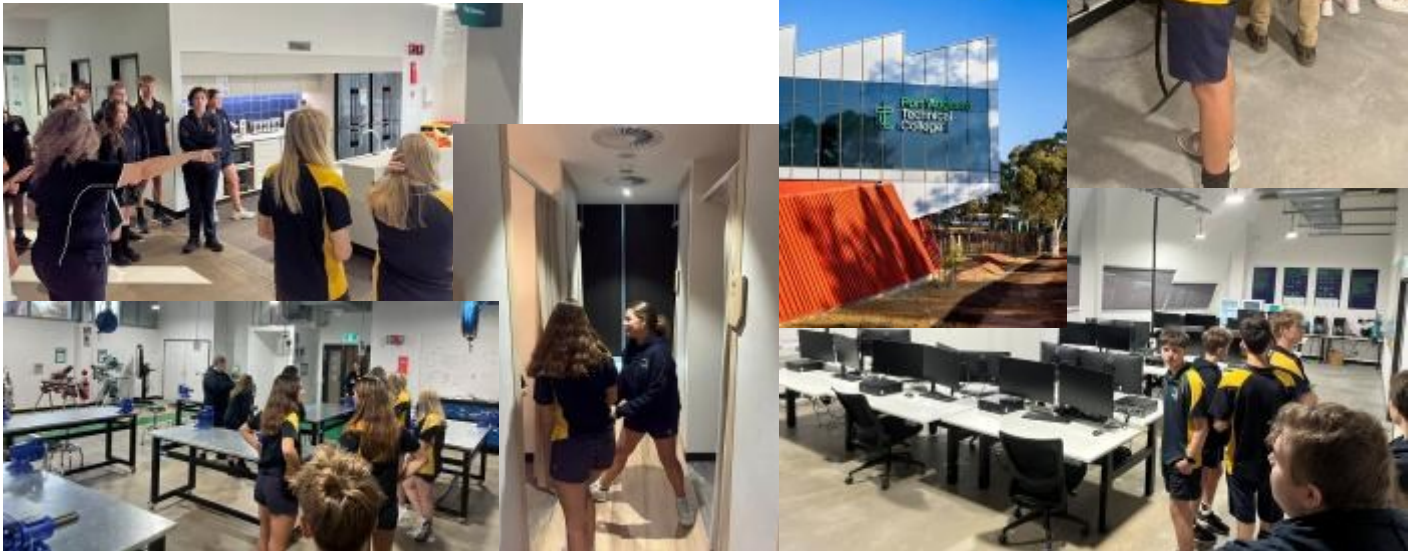

Port Augusta Technical College

Today our year 9/10 students visited the newly opened Port Augusta Technical College. The College opened this year for year 10-12 students and provides training in four career pathways - Civil Engineering, Health, Multi-Trades and Cookery/Tourism. The College has overnight accommodation facilities and runs a free bus service to bring day students or block students. Block students arrive Sunday afternoons and return home the following Friday. Students who attend are treated like they are in a workplace setting rather than school. This includes signing in each day and having to go without their phones during the work day.
