In Reception we have created our mural using our handprints in a big colourful circle. Each handprint shows that we are important and included in our class. Our artwork is decorated with dot art, inspired by Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander artists.

This mural stands for RESPECT, one of our school values because we are kind to each other, listen, and make sure everyone belongs.

We made this mural for Reconciliation Week, celebrating the importance of respect and learning together, just like our school community.



Year 2/3 - Success

Year 2 /3's mural celebrates Success. Each of us created a ray of sunshine and decorated it with Aboriginal inspired art. Together our rays form a bright sun because our class shines the brightest when everyone contributes.

Our sun is a symbol of achieving our goals and being proud of what we do - just like our school value of success.

During Reconciliation Week, we are learning that success is about working and celebrating together with respect, inspired by the traditions and art of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples



Year 1 /2 - Resilience

In Year 1 /2, our mural shows a strong tree growing tall. Each leaf was added by a student to show a time when we tried again or kept going, even when things were hard. We used cotton buds to make dot patterns on the leaves, connecting our art to Aboriginal traditions.

The mural is about RESILIENCE, one of our school values because, just like trees grow stronger every year, we become braver by learning and trying our best.

Our tree is a symbol for Reconciliation Week, reminding us that we all grow together when we support each other.

Year 4 /5 - We Walk Together

In Year 4 /5 each student created an individual artwork using dot painting, Aboriginal symbols, and traditional techniques. Our "We Walk Together" theme reminds us that, while each journey is unique, we support and respect one another. Together, our art celebrates unity, understanding, and the strength we find in walking forward, side by side.



Year 5 /6 - All In

In Year 5/6 our mural brings the "All In" theme of Reconciliation Week to life. Each student designed their own artwork using dot art and traditional symbols inspired by Aboriginal art techniques. Together, our artwork shows that everyone is valued and included when we are "All In" we build a stronger kinder school community.

This mural connects to the idea of inclusion and teamwork also reminds us that reconciliation means bringing everyone together, honouring diversity, and working towards a shared future.

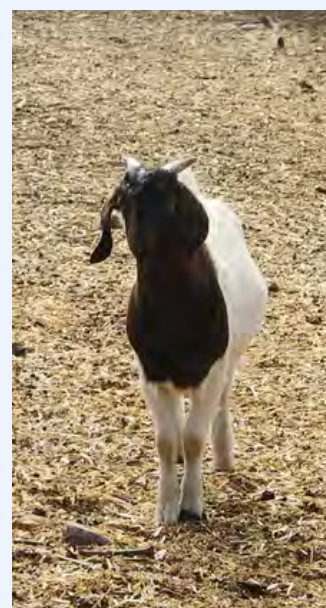

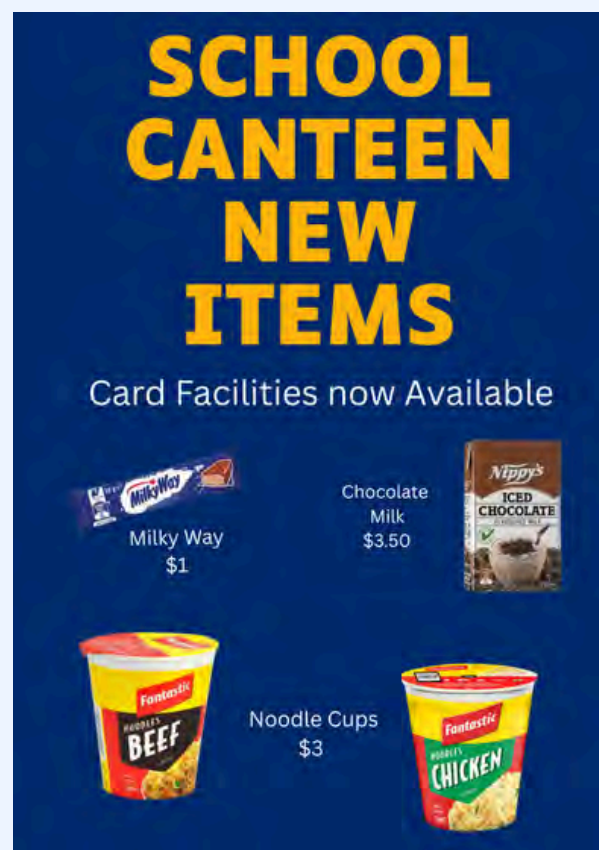

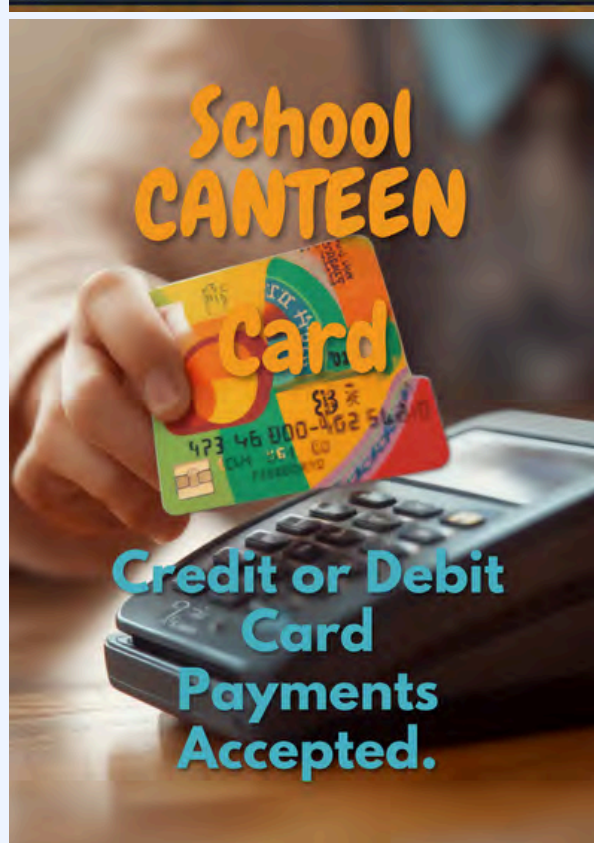
